| <b>Flowers:</b> There are so many variables ranging from a single flower to a coffin length floral spray that it is impossible to give a set price. A guideline would be:  | Posy/cushion/heart                      | from <b>£30</b>          |

|  | Special design (dog/cat/bear/cross etc) | from <b>£150</b>         |

| <b>Notice in the newspaper:</b> This depends on the newspaper and the length of the notice. A standard notice in a local/regional paper may cost approximately <b>£150</b> where as the same notice in a national paper may cost <b>£400</b> . |   |                          |

| <b>Cemetery fees:</b><br>Each cemetery sets their own fees which means they can vary significantly. A non-resident often has to pay more than a resident. Generally, cemetery fees are split into two sections:   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Exclusive Right of Burial (This means no one else can be buried there for a predetermined number of years and gives you the right to be able to install a headstone after the funeral).</li> <li>• Interment fee (The cost of being buried in the cemetery, usually including the grave digging).</li> </ul> | <p>Guide price for a resident:<br/><b>£150-1,534</b></p> <p>Guide price for a resident:<br/><b>£415-921</b></p> |
| <b>Catering:</b> There are so many variables it is impossible to give a price, it may be the cost of tea and coffee if you choose to have a gathering at your home address or considerably more if booking a venue with a full buffet available.
